the mission of developing and providing training and vocational opportunities for the individuals it serves, Marimor committed to entering this business with only a handful of known customers.



The months before start up saw a dedicated and increased amount of advertising. TV, radio and billboards around Allen County helped to spread the word of Marimor's new service and by the end of the first year in business Secure Shred had processed 176,050.5 pounds of documents.

Since that time, Secure Shred has grown to become a well known, respected and trusted resource for document destruction in West Central Ohio and the surrounding areas. By the end of January 2012, Marimor's Secure Shred division had shred and recycled over 4 million pounds of paper.

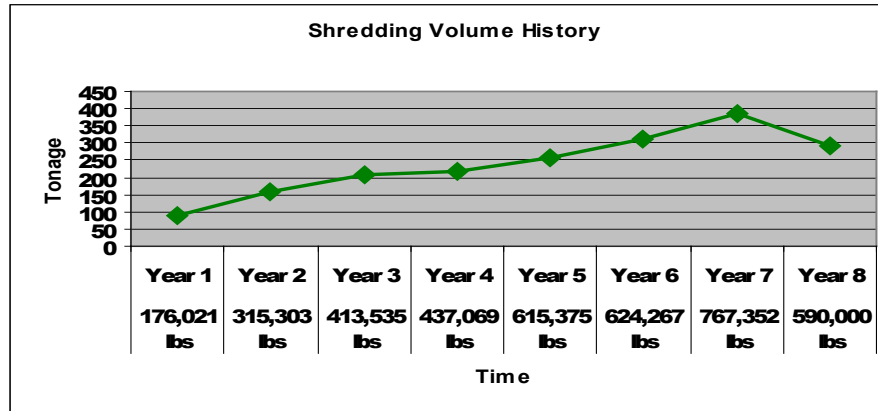

From August 2004 to today, Secure Shred has processed over 4 million pounds of paper, or 2000 tons. This paper has been milled and manufactured into a variety of recycled paper products, which, in turn, result in saving and promoting the responsible use of our valuable natural resources.

Water

The United States has a supply of fresh water equal to 600 billion gallons of water a day. By 1985 daily usage of water in the U.S. had reached 422 billion gallons per day.

It takes 30,000 gallons to produce one ton of steel, 200 gallons to make one pound of synthetic rubber and 184,000 gallons for a ton of high quality book paper.*

Paper recycling lessens water usage and, over the last five years, shredding through Secure Shred has resulted in saving over 14 million gallons of water. If the water saved through Secure Shred were used to fill a pool, the pool would have to be 3738 feet long, 700 feet wide and 140 feet deep.

There are 25 countries in Central and North America. Seven of the forests in these continents are in danger of deforestation.



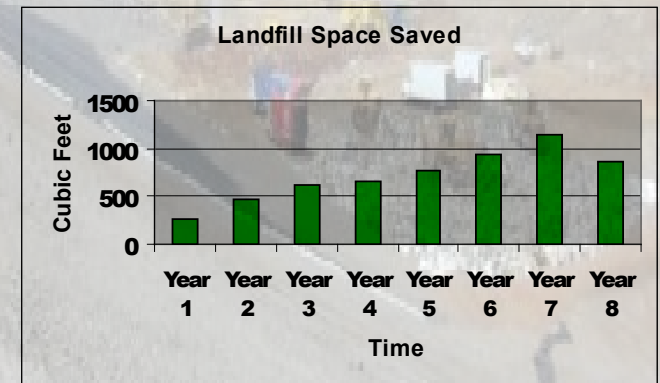
It is estimated that 17 trees are spared for every ton of paper recycled. Through the efforts of Marimor Industries, Inc. Secure Shred, its customers and clients the following number of trees have been saved:

- Year 1 : 1496 Trees Spared
- Year 2: 2680 Trees Spared
- Year 3: 3515 Trees Spared
- Year 4: 3723 Trees Spared
- Year 5: 4397 Trees Spared
- Year 6: 5304 Trees Spared
- Year 7: 6522 Trees Spared
- Year 8: 5015 Trees Spared
- Total: 32,652 Trees Spared



landfill Space

Shredding and recycling paper helps reduce the amount of landfill space used. One ton of recycled paper saves the equivalent of three cubic feet of landfill space.



Total landfill space saved = 5746 cubic feet
